Reception

- From **Monday to Friday** from 7:30 to 12:00 am
- **Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday** also in the afternoon from 2:00 to 5:00 pm
- **Saturday and Sunday** from 8:00 to 12:00 am
- **Laboratory tests:** every day from 7:30 to 10:00 am

PSYCHIATRY AND CLINICAL PSYCHOLOGY

For accessing psychiatric and psychological services a preliminary evaluation at the **Psychological Assessment Service - SAV** - is needed. Access is free and no reservation is needed, ask for information at the reception desk. Reception hours are from Monday to Friday from 8.30 am to 1.30 pm. The following outpatient services are available:

Minors The child neuropsychiatry service is addressed to Italian and foreign minors and their families, unaccompanied minors, international protection seekers and victims of human trafficking. It offers psychodiagnostic, treatment and counselling activities particularly focused on adolescent problems and psychological trauma treatment.

Homeless and Socially Disadvantaged People

A transdisciplinary team provides information, guidance and medical, psychological and anthropological assistance to Italian and foreign homeless people at risk of social fragility and exclusion.

Women's Rights and Health The Service is addressed to young and adult women in need for medical assistance for reasons related with sexual health and emotional education. A socially and culturally sensitive approach is adopted. The service provides health education, medical assistance, information and prevention activities and psychological support/therapy for women victims of physical and psychological violence and for their minor children.

The service provides the entitled persons with the codes **STP (Foreigner Temporarily Present)** and **ENI (European Person not Registered with the National Health Service)** for accessing the services of the National Health Service.

Social Medicine: some activities are carried on in the framework of specific projects, i.e. audiology and OCT (Optical Coherence Tomography).

SOCIAL AND HEALTH CARE SERVICES

Social And Health Assistance Desk The service provides guidance, support and mediation aimed at analysing, assessing and supporting people with complex needs. The service is managed by transcultural mediators who receive and decode people requests, also referring them to other services (medical, psychological, social and nurse services) for taking care of particularly complex situations. The service is accessible without reservation and closely cooperates the social worker.

Service for International Protection Seekers and Refugees

An interdisciplinary team provides medical, psychological and social support to international protection seekers and refugees. Medical examinations, psychological counselling, information and guidance. When required, a dossier to be attached to the refugee application is issued.

"The Street Lawyer" Service About 30 lawyers and apprentices, supported by a transcultural mediator, work as volunteers to offer free judicial and extrajudicial legal support to citizens deprived of their fundamental rights who have administrative, civil and criminal legal problems. Access is free and no reservation is needed.

ASGI Service (Association for Law Studies on Immigration)

The service aims at promoting information on the immigration laws, citizenship and asylum, on the conditions of foreigners, stateless people and refugees, on the protection against discrimination, racism and xenophobia. It also offers legal assistance for assertion and protection of rights, fight against discrimination, violence, incitement to delinquency and violence, particularly as regards acts and omissions towards foreigners (stateless and refugees). Access to legal services is free and no reservation is needed.
